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School Uniform

A school uniform provides children with a sense of belonging. We are proud of our uniform at Victoria Junior School and we would like to remind parents that we expect the correct uniform to be worn every day in school. The P.E kit is the uniform for P.E lessons and must only be worn on P.E days or on a Wednesday and/or Thursday if attending a club. The P.E kit should be worn along with the school jumper.

Our school uniform consists of:

- A maroon sweatshirt or cardigan
- Grey or black trousers, shorts or skirt.
- Pale blue or white polo shirt or blouse.
- Summer: as above, or a blue and white or striped or checked dress.

Our P.E Kit consists of:

- Plain white t-Shirt
- Black shorts
- Black jogging bottoms
- Trainers or plimsolls
- The School jumper must be worn over the T-Shirt
- No hoodies or designer wear

Please do not send your child to school wearing jewellery unless it is for religious reasons. Earrings should only be plain, small studs and removed for P.E/Swimming.
