Although your child has already been informed of their results of the end of key stage tests that they sat in May, you will find below the results and teacher assessments in full.

The scaled score is created from the number of marks your child scored in each test. The scaled scores are used to report the results of these tests to ensure accurate comparisons of performance can be made over time. At KS2 the range of scaled scores is 80 to 120. A scaled score:

- below 100 means that your child may need more support to help them reach the expected standard
- of 100 or more means that your child is working at, or above, the expected standard for the key stage
- 110 or above means that your child is working at greater depth within the expected standard

I have also devised a table to show the percentage of Victoria Junior School pupils who achieved 100 or above in the scaled score with the figure nationally.

Victoria Junior School 2019 compared to National results in 2019

English - Reading	56%	73%
English - Writing	57%	78%
Mathematics	68%	79%
Reading, Writing and Mathematics	51%	65%

Whilst the final percentage of pupils achieving the age expected standard is disappointing, we believe that the efforts of the adults and pupils have been rewarded in the vast majority of the results seen. We are not resting on these results by any means and have plans to share with parents and carers in September about how we will improve the school further in the future.
