

Place a range of items on a tray, and allow 5 minutes (or less) for your child to look at those items. Take the tray away and ask your child to recall the items.

This can be altered by taking away a few items on the tray when your child isn't looking and then asking them to name what is missing.

To adapt this game to support auditory memory skills – a range of sounds or words can be played. Ask your child to repeat what they have heard.
